

Arnold earned her doctorate in Higher Education Management from the University of Pennsylvania, where she also earned a master's degree in Social Work. She holds a bachelor's degree in Psychology and Social Welfare from Penn State University.

Prior to practicing social work as a higher education administrator, Dr. Arnold served in more traditional social work settings. She held various positions including Adoption/Foster Care Specialist, Clinical Social Worker and Family Planning Counselor. While in her position as Director of Human Resources and Community Relations at Crime Prevention Association, Dr. Arnold served as a liaison to the United Way of Southeastern Pennsylvania. Dr. Arnold also served as a Chief of Services at the Navy Family Services Centers in Hampton Roads, Virginia.

Dr. Arnold's personal accomplishments are complemented by her dedication to the community. She has served on several community boards including Episcopal Community Services and St. Mary's Family Respite Center in Philadelphia, PA. As a resident of Grand Rapids, she now serves on the board of Heart of West Michigan United Way, Girl Scouts of Michigan Shore to Shore, Huntington Bank Women's Advisory Board, Grand Rapids Community Foundation Community Action Committee, the YWCA Human Resources Committee, and the University of Pennsylvania Alumni Secondary School Committee (Chair – Grand Rapids).
